Bedrooms

To ensure the comfort of your stay, we have installed smart temperature controllers in every room. They have been pre-set to a comfortable temperature. Should you wish to bring it up or down, simply turn the knob.

The radiators are yet another way of us looking after your thermal comfort and the environment. They have been specially designed to remain safely cool to the touch on the outside, so if they appear cold, rest assured, they still work by maintaining the temperature set on your wall thermostat.

Finally, our windows have been equipped with special sensors which help to reduce the CO2 emission of our heating installation. They do this by turning the heating off when the window is open. As soon as the window is closed, the radiator will turn itself back on if the room temperature requires adjustment to your desirable level set on the wall thermostat.

Due to Health & Safety regulations the windows cannot open more than the stoppers/restrictors fitted.

If you wish for your towels to be replaced, please leave them in your bath or shower.

Laundry services are open between the hours of **10am-2pm**.

Should you require laundry services, please separate your laundry into mixed and whites into your laundry bags. These are located on the shelf in your wardrobe, alternatively they can be provided at reception.

Please ensure Reception are aware of your laundry services, housekeeping will collect and deliver your items back to your room by the end of the day.

Laundry & Drying is a charge of £10 per bag.

Llandudno Attractions

Tourists flock to Llandudno for decades, making it the perfect all-in-one vacation spot for every family member. With an authentic Victorian pier, magnificent castles, and charming farm parks featuring adorable animals, there is something for everyone to enjoy in this beloved destination.

The Great Orme

A place for perfect exploration, it has hidden Alice in Wonderland statues. Happy Valley Gardens will keep you smiling. Legend has it if you walk around the standing stones as the sun is setting, it will bring you good fortune. Haulfre Gardens is the perfect stroll down to West Shore Beach.

Great Orme Copper Mine

Uncovered in 1987 during a scheme to landscape the Great Orme, the copper mines discovered represent one of the most astounding archaeological discoveries of recent times. Dating back 4,000 years to the Bronze Age, they change our views about the ancient people of Britain and their civilized and structured society 2,000 years before the Roman invasion.

Over the past 28 years, mining engineers, cavers, and archaeologists have been slowly uncovering more tunnels and large areas of the surface landscape, revealing what is now thought to be the largest prehistoric mine discovered in the world.

Great Orme Tramway

The Tramway climbs a mile (1500m) through Great Orme Country Park and Nature Reserve to Great Orme's spectacular summit. Re-live the experience of travel more than 100 years ago in lovingly restored original tramcars, each named after a Saint.

Great Orme Cable Cars

The Llandudno cable cars have been running every year since June 1969 and are renowned for being the most comprehensive passenger cable car system in Britain. This inimitable experience continues to be one of the town's most popular tourist attractions, as well as the Great Orme Tramway which, opened in 1902 and is now 'Britain's only surviving cable street tramway, and one of three in the world.'

The Great Orme Llandudno is home to the longest toboggan run in Britain, including an impressive dry ski slope, with a new ski-tech surface to enhance the customer experience.

It inspired Alice in Wonderland

Legend has it that Alice Liddell, the inspiration for Lewis Carroll's Alice in Wonderland, would often frequent the town with her family for a holiday but the exact details and facts remain unclear.

This hasn't stopped town officials from erecting statues dedicated to the much beloved series of novels and no matter how tenuous the link may be, locals and tourists embrace the lore nonetheless.

There are many shipwrecks in Belmont.

Over 30 of them, to be exact.

Due to the less than great conditions and lack of assistance that many sailors and merchants had to endure, Belmont is the final resting place for many unfortunate souls.

The Phoenix is believed to be the largest wreck located in the bay and the warship is estimated to have crashed as far back in 1642.

Llandudno could have been called Port Wrexham

That is, if St George's Harbour & Railway Company had their way.

Llandudno was once seen as little more than an export base for the then wildly popular Denbighshire coal as it was a one horse town back in the day.

However, thanks to Lord Mostyn, the proud town is now one of the jewels of the Welsh crown and is known as the Queen of Welsh Resorts for good reason!
